## **A little bit of information you may find interesting:**

Since their inception over twenty five years ago, the Palmerston and Rural Markets have been administered from a private residence – there is no shop front or registered office. This situation is not set to change.

The Markets are only administered from the beginning of February through to the end of October each year. November, December and January are not likely to illicit a timely response should you make contact during that time.

All applications are tabled before the Committee for consideration and approval. Committee meetings are only held once a month. Many food applications are placed on hold due a shortage of powered sites. Every effort is made to make contact either by phone or email to advise of your application’s outcome. Not every effort is successful however, particularly given the unreliability of telecommunications – especially in the Wet Season.

Applications for the 2012 season will be available on our website in December 2011. You are welcome to submit an application but do not expect a response prior to the first Committee Meeting in March 2012.

**The first Market for 2012 is Friday 20<sup>th</sup> April.**
